IS A HISTORY FOCUS ON ANCIENT GREECE



WHAT WILL BE LEARNED:

Maths	We shall continue to learn informal and formal methods for multiplication and division before progressing into fractions.
English	We shall be reading a variety of Greek myths, looking at inference, sequencing, predictions and building understanding of features of what makes a myth before progressing into writing our own Greek myth. We shall also develop our sentence structure, continuing to build understanding of fronted adverbials, using prepositions and beginning to understand the correct use and layout of inverted commas for speech.
Science	Not directly taught this term.
History/ Geography	We shall continue to build understanding of the Ancient Greek period, focusing on worship including the many God and Goddesses and temples and starting to understand the legacy of the Ancient Greek period in science, sport and education.
D.T/Art	We shall link our Ancient Greek learning to building yo-yos!
French	We shall learn names for different foods and develop conversational skills to ask for food in restaurants.
Computing	We shall follow our I-Compute scheme learning on coding, as well as using search engines to support our topic learning, including reminding ourselves about how to stay safe on line.
PSHE/No outsiders RSE	Our <i>No Outsiders</i> will continue to challenge stereotypes and build understanding and acceptance of a multicultural and diverse Britain. We shall follow our prescribed scheme for PSHE.
Music	We shall listen to a range of music, improvising our own in response to stimuli.
PE	We shall continue to build skills in invasion games and start to build skills in gymnastics.
