

# This half term in Owls

## GREECE

This half term our learning on Greece is continuing.

Don't forget our Ancient Greek day towards the end of this half term that you received a letter about before Christmas.

## WHAT WILL BE LEARNED

Maths	In Maths we will be learning about multiplication and division consolidating prior learning and understanding new rules. The children will also extend their understanding of statistics and fractions. Times Tables is a main focus for this year as it is the national expectation that all children will know all their times tables up to 12 x 12 and be confident with rapid and random recall by the end of Year 4.
English	They will be writing fact files about Greek Gods and Goddesses and writing their own myths.
Science	No Science will be taught this half term.
Geography	No Geography will be taught this half term.
D.T/Art	They are going to design and create their own Ancient Greek shields and make some yoyos using outdoor resources!
PE	They will be playing different invasion games, gymnastics and dancing.
French	They will be learning the names of different food and how to order something in a restaurant.
Computing	In Computing we will be completing our online safety learning.
PSHE/No outsiders RSE	Our No Outsiders story will be 'Aalfred & Aalbert' which teaches us about finding common ground with each other.
Music	Brass lessons will happen each week with an outside teacher.
RE	We will be looking at Christianity. We will be thinking about the symbol of the cross and what it represents.
Visitors/Visits	Tuesday 1st April– Ancient Greek Day

## IMPORTANT REMINDERS

- Please remember to label all your child's clothing with their name.
