

This half term in Owls

MOVING AND GROWING

WHAT WILL BE LEARNED

This half term our learning is inspired by the theme of **“Moving and Growing.”** During this mainly Scientific topic, we shall be thinking about Plants and humans.

Maths	In Maths we will be learning about decimals. The children will also extend their understanding of fractions. Times Tables is a main focus for this year as it is the national expectation that all children will know all their times tables up to 12 x 12 and be confident with rapid and random recall by the end of Year 4. Our times table check will be at the beginning of next half term
English	We will be doing some descriptive writing about Spring and research and fact files about Darwin.
Science	We will be learning about plants, as well as human and animal skeletons and muscles.
Geography/History	Not taught this half term.
D.T/Art	In our Art learning we will be learning about various famous artists that create plant artwork. We will be expressing our options, doing observational drawings and painting using different tones and shades.
PE	They will be doing athletics and racket sports.
French	Not taught this half term.
Computing	In Computing we will be learning to use emails to communicate with our friends.
PSHE/No outsiders RSE	Our No Outsiders story will be ‘When sadness comes to call’ which focuses on mental health. We will be thinking what mental health is, how situations can affect our mental health and strategies to look after our mental health.
Music	Brass lessons will happen each week with an outside teacher.
RE	We will be looking at Christianity. We will be thinking about the Kingdom of God.
Visitors/Visits	Thorpe Woodlands– 12th until the 14th May.
