IS A SCIENCE FOCUS ON LOCAL AND GLOBAL HABITATS



WHAT WILL BE LEARNED:

Maths	We shall continue our focus on measures, applying our previous number work and operations to capacity and money. We shall also revisit fractions and extend understanding of 2D and 3D shapes and data.
English	We shall continue to write creatively across the curriculum, inspired by our work on habitats and the Amazon rainforest in particular. We shall use figurative language in poetry, write balanced arguments, revisit language and sentence structure for persuasive writing as well as the rules for dialogue in conjunction with building powerful language in narrative writing based on our book for the half term, <i>The Great Kapok Tree</i> .
Science	We shall be learning about local and global habitats, as well as using identification keys to classify various vertebrates and invertebrates.
History/ Geography	Not directly taught this term.
D.T/Art	In art, we shall be looking at William Morris to inspire our work for printing. In DT we shall be making moving books.
RE	We will follow our Suffolk RE scheme, exploring Judaism
Computing	We shall follow our I-Compute scheme learning on databases and create our own Podcasts.
PSHE/No outsiders RSE	Our <i>No Outsiders</i> will continue to challenge stereotypes and build understanding and acceptance of a multicultural and diverse Britain. We shall follow our prescribed scheme for PSHE.
French	We shall be learning about the names of different parts of our body and names for animals.
PE	We shall continue to develop skills in athletics and tennis. One off lesson in climbing—Thursday 5th June.
