

This half term in Kingfishers we are studying ...

SETTLERS AND SETTLEMENTS

OUR TOPIC IS A HISTORY FOCUS.

Maths	In Maths, we shall be revising and building on our understanding of analogue time and begin to read digital times. This will also include reading timetables and calendars. We shall also continue to build on multiplication and division strategies as well as beginning to learn our 4 times tables and continuing to revise our 2,3, 5 and 10 times tables.
English	In English, we shall continue to extend our understanding of sentence structures, revisiting our knowledge of adjectives, verbs and adverbs to engage our reader as well as starting to think of more interesting ways to start sentences. Using the book <i>Winter of the Wolves</i> as a stimulus, we shall empathise with the main character, writing diary entries from their perspective, write persuasive letters and revise the layout and language of non chronological reports to support our history learning on the Anglo Saxons.
Science	Our focus shall be on forces and magnets.
Music	We shall be learning about timbre and making our own compositions using body percussion.
Art	We will investigate sculpture as a a form of art, before using different materials to plan and make our own Anglo Saxon settlement. We shall investigate weaving as an art form.
Computing	We shall follow our iCompute scheme of work around the importance of e-safety.
PSHE/No outsiders RSE	Our <i>No Outsiders</i> will continue to build understanding and acceptance of a multicultural and diverse Britain. In RE, we will follow separate Suffolk planning, learning about influential people in the Hindu faith.
PE	Our PE this term will be gymnastics and invasion games.
