Summer Term 2

This half term in Robins our theme is

'...In A Land Far, Far Away...'

This half term the children will be travelling across our oceans around and discover treasures inspired by art from around the world. Children will sail the seas, uncover hidden wonders, and immerse themselves in the colours, patterns and stories of different cultures. Along the way, they'll bring their discoveries to life through creative projects, designing, building and imagining their own epic tales of adventure. Our last half term is a busy one! Make a note of the dates to remember!

Maths	This half term children will be taking their key stage 1 SATS as part of my ongoing teacher assessments. These will be taking place in small groups with myself. There will be an Arithmetic paper and a Reasoning paper which each child will complete as part of lessons during the school day. We will also be completing our units on time, statistics and position/ direction.
English	This half term the children will be taking their Key Stage 1 SATS as part of my ongoing teacher assessments. These will be taking place in small groups with myself. There will be a Spelling, Grammar and Punctuation paper and two Reading papers. Each child will complete these as part of lessons during the school day. We will also be looking at some poetry and stories based on different parts of the world.
Science	Robins will continue to explore plants by identifying common flowers, trees and garden plants in our grounds, as well as learning how they mature as they grow and reproduce. We will also be carrying out a range of seasonal investigations linked to countries.
Geography	We will learn about the seas that surround the UK. We will develop knowledge of the oceans and continents of the world. We will investigate how waves are caused and how they move. Inspired by the stormy seascapes of J. M. W. Turner. We will travel around the world comparing countries.
Art	We will be going on an exciting journey through the world of Australian art! We will develop art skills while learning about a range of different Australian painting techniques and styles, including dot painting and cross-hatching. We will then use these techniques to decorate a variety of Australian artefacts, such as boomerangs and rainsticks!
PE	In P.E the games sessions will be based around striking and fielding and invasion games and continuing on our OAA journey using our school grounds to make learning active.
French	Robins will continue to be introduced to the basic understanding of the French language, looking at greetings, introducing ourselves, numbers, colours and our family.
Computing	In this unit of learning children will develop their writing and digital literacy skills by learning how to craft blog posts and address questions.
PSHE / No outsiders & RSE	We will be looking at the faith Judaism and looking at the question, 'Why is the Torah such a joy for the Jewish community?' In PSHE we will continue our journey with Yasmine and Tom, looking at how to stay safe in the sun.
Music	We continue our journey learning the Recorder, developing rhythm, coordination, and early notation skills. We will also look at singing cumulative songs and improvising actions, using images as a score to underpin structure.
